



LEATHER JACKET WORKSHOP

August 16-20, 2009, Vancouver, B.C. with Kathryn Brenne and Cecelia Podolak

Treat yourself to a luxurious leather jacket and a four-day plus sewing vacation! Leather expert, Kathryn Brenne will guide you through the construction of one of Cecelia Podolak's Fearless Jackets or Vest or pattern of your choice in garment weight leather.

As well as working on their own garments, students will complete a variety of samples for future reference. All students will be asked to bring a ready-to-fit muslin of their garment to class where Cecelia will help you achieve a great fit before you cut into leather. Please feel free to call Kathryn or Cecelia to discuss your pattern selection and alterations.

The workshop will begin the evening of August 16 with a small trunk show and discussion of leather garment details. Students will then have four full days to work on samples and their own garment. Please note that Kathryn will help you to select/purchase fabric.

Classes will be held in a state-of-the-art classroom with industrial sewing machines and irons, large cutting tables, and great light.

Kathryn Brenne is the owner of The Academy of Fine Sewing & Design, designer of the Travel Skirt pattern and frequent contributor to Vogue Pattern magazine, Butterick Home Catalogue and THREADS magazine. She has made guest appearances on the television show Sew Much More and is a popular instructor at sewing shows across the country.

Cecelia Podolak, Material Things, is the designer of The Classics Patterns and an expert in fitting and jacket construction. Her new shorter, fitted jacket pattern has been especially designed for fabric or leather.

SUPPLIES:

Students will be able to pre-order and purchase skins directly from Kathryn if they are unable to locate a local supplier. A list of supplies and notions needed for the workshop will be sent prior to class.

LOCATION:

Trunk Show will be held in Cecelia's Studio, 60-101 Parkside Drive, Port Moody, BC. Daily classes will be held at Eric Hamber Secondary School, 5025 Willow Street Vancouver, BC.

TUITION FEES:

Class tuition of \$700.00 CDN includes 4 days of instruction, sample kit, handouts, wine/cheese social, morning and afternoon beverage breaks, and daily lunches. A non-refundable deposit of \$200 CDN will reserve your spot with the remainder due by July 17, 2009.

Class size is limited providing maximum individual attention. In the event that you must cancel after July 17, 2009, half of the balance will be returned to you. If your space can be filled, the other half will be refunded. In the event that the course is cancelled, students will be fully reimbursed.
